CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) Mrs. Hardy brief the duties of CASA volunteers and their purpose. When a child enters the foster care systems because his or her home is no longer safe due to abuse or neglect, a judge may appoint a committed volunteer to advocate for the child's (or sibling group's) best interest both in and outside the courtroom. These trained advocates — empowered directly by the courts — offer the critical information they need to ensure that each child's right and needs are being attended to while in foster care. CASA volunteers are ordinary citizens doing extraordinary things. All have one thing in common: they are passionately committed to helping children. Every child deserves to be protected and cared for and it's our obligation as a community to be their voice to insure they get proper care and are kept safe within the system. Stand up for a child, so they stand a chance.
